A Word from the Police Chief

Tomorrow afternoon (June 2), there is a protest scheduled in Marin City. Over the past two days, there have been several peaceful demonstrations in Marin communities with none of the aftermath we are witnessing in larger metropolitan areas. However, this planned protest is much closer to our community.

In addition, we are aware of social media postings encouraging participants to shift their attention to more affluent communities, with a specific mention of Walnut Creek, Danville, Sausalito, and Tiburon. These posts were clearly not written by individuals interested in peaceful protest, and a common tactic that has been repeated in many demonstrations is attempting to block freeways. This can escalate into attacks of vehicles and their occupants. As a result, we are recommending that if possible, you refrain from travel on US-101 south of Tiburon Boulevard tomorrow afternoon and evening.

In response, Tiburon Police has substantially increased our staffing, and we will remain at this elevated staffing level as long as is needed.
