I am also very thankful and pleased to announce that the Marin County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to ratify the Marin County Council of Mayors and Councilmembers' appointment of me to the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway, and Transportation District Board. I want to thank my colleagues for their strong support and I am very excited to represent all of Marin at the Bridge Board! I appreciate everyone's confidence in me to serve Tiburon and all of Marin on this very important Board.

This past year, we have many things to be thankful for. We demonstrated our commitment to diversity and inclusion with the establishment and hard work of the Diversity Inclusion Task Force, adding a Diversity Element to the General Plan, calling for the Town Council to have a role in ensuring diversity in our hiring and employment policies, and our very successful Juneteenth Event. We showed our strong commitment to the environment, by passing the Climate Emergency Resolution, by adding a Climate Element to the General Plan, and by working very hard to eliminate toxic chemicals from being sprayed on Blackie's Pasture through our continuing work on our Integrated Pest Management Policy. We have seen downtown Tiburon revitalized before our very eyes with the opening of The Bungalow Kitchen by Michael Mina and Brent Bolthouse, the reopening of The Caprice, and The Caviar Company, Squalo Vino, Perfect Provenance, welcoming Servino back to Ark Row, Main Street Mercantile, Trinity House Paintings, Tiburon Wine Bar and Renee Rivera Couture.

But all of this work does not happen without our amazing Commissioners and staff at Town Hall. I want to thank each and every one of you for your public service and commitment to making Tiburon the best Town in which to live, work, and play.

I hope that you can share something you are thankful for with your family and friends around the Thanksgiving table.
