



## First Chipper Day of the Season This Saturday at the Tiburon Peninsula Club Lot

The season for vegetation management is already here! The first Chipper Day of the season is this **Saturday, May 14 from 9AM-4PM** at the Tiburon Peninsula Club parking lot.

All Tiburon and Belvedere residents can drive their vegetation cuttings and "slash" to be piled for chipper removal courtesy of the Tiburon Fire and Southern Marin Fire Districts and the Tiburon Department of Public Works. Proactive vegetation management helps you and your neighbors create defensible space to make our whole community better protected against wildfire.

**The May Chipper Day will be held at the Tiburon Peninsula Club parking lot.** Vehicles should dump cuttings in assigned areas and will need to inform staff from where the cut vegetation was removed. This information is used to track compliance efforts and target tonnage removal. Please see the graphic for instructions below.

## Town Council Takes a Stand Against Anti-Semitism

In February, dozens of anti-Semitic flyers were found on properties in Marin County, including those of Tiburon residents.

The Town Council and the Town's Diversity Inclusion Task Force heard directly from impacted residents and immediately took action to publicly condemn the incident, which unfortunately was not the first incidence of anti-Semitism in our community.



On April 20, 2022, the Tiburon Town Council adopted [Town Council Resolution No. 11-2022](#), formally taking a stance condemning all incidences of anti-Semitism, hatred, hate crimes, and bigotry. In the resolution, the Council also declared its support for Jewish American Heritage Month in the month of May and for the passage of State Assembly Bill 2282, which will make it easier for law enforcement to prosecute hateful incidents and prevent them from occurring in Tiburon.

## June 7 Primary is Marin's First Election with New Vote Centers

The upcoming primary election will be Marin County's first election with voting based on the State's new voting model. Read on to make sure you know how to cast your vote in June.

The Voter's Choice Act is a new law that offers voters more choices for how, when, and where to vote. What changed? Now, all active registered voters are automatically mailed a ballot, early voting is expanded for more days, and voters may vote in-person at a regional vote center.

## How Does It Work?

All active registered voters will automatically be mailed a ballot and have three ways to return it:

- By mail (no stamp needed)
- At an official ballot drop box ([List of drop box locations](#))
- At a vote center

## What is a Vote Center?

Voters may vote in-person at ANY vote center in Marin County. Assigned, neighborhood polling places are replaced by regional vote centers that open at least 3 days before Election Day. At a vote center, voters can also register to vote, replace a lost or damaged ballot, vote early, vote with an accessible voting machine, or request help.

The closest vote center to Tiburon will be the Westminster Presbyterian Church, which will be open for voting June 4 - June 7, but Tiburon voters can vote at any vote center. [Review the list of all vote centers available to Marin County residents here.](#)

## Del Mar Middle School Traffic Calming Project Begins 5/23

MERCOZA Construction has been contracted by the Town of Tiburon to create safer pedestrian crossings near Del Mar Middle School.

Work is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 23 and conclude on Friday, July 29. Work hours will be 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The majority of the work will be on the shoulder and traffic control will be in place during construction. Please mind all traffic control devices and signage when traveling through the work zones.



The improvements include the following:

### **Intersection 1: Howard Drive & Hilary Drive**

- Refresh existing red curb and crosswalk at the intersection
- Install a new stop pavement stencil and stop bar on Hilary Drive

### **Intersection 2: Howard Drive & Rowley Circle**

- Install new high visibility crosswalk across Howard Drive
- Install new bulb out with pedestrian ramp and associated signage

### **Intersection 3: Rowley Circle & Geldert Court**

- Install new pavement stencils on Rowley Circle, new red curb along Geldert Court and new pedestrian signage at the existing crosswalk.

### **Intersection 4: Hilary Drive & Rowley Circle**

- Install a second new high visibility crosswalk across Hilary Drive
- Install new bulb out with pedestrian ramp and associated signage and pavement stencils

### **Intersections 5 and 6: Avenida Miraflores & Felipa Court & Hilary Drive**

- Install pedestrian signage and new red curbs at the intersection of Avenida Miraflores and Hilary Drive
- Install new bulb out with pedestrian ramp, refuge island, and associated signage and striping on Avenida Miraflores at Felipa Court



## 2022-23 Tennis and Pickleball Court Keys Now Available

The 2022-23 season tennis/pickleball court keys are now available for purchase from the Ranch. The purchase of a court key allows you walk-on access to the Point Tiburon and Lagoon Road courts and access to an online reservation system.

The purchase of a court key is not required for enrollment in group lessons or to book private lessons. Keyholders are entitled to reserve 1 hour per day and reservation slots are 1 hour long.

In a Get Ready class, you will learn how to prepare kits for your home, car, and workplace, make good communication and evacuation plans for your family, how and when to turn off your utilities, and how to prepare your home for fire, earthquake, power outage, and winter storms.
