The Town is updating the Tiburon Housing Element as part of the General Plan update. All jurisdictions in the Bay Area, including Tiburon, must update their Housing Element for the 2023-2031 planning period. As a result of new State requirements, the Housing Element must contain provisions allowing for significant new housing to be built in Tiburon.

All members of the community are encouraged to review the draft Housing Element and invited to submit comments and feedback to the Town before the public review period ends on Friday, August 5, 2022.
