

One-Way Traffic Control Along Tiburon Blvd. Monday, July 10 - Friday, July 14

Caltrans will be conducting vegetation management work on Tiburon Boulevard between Trestle Glen and Rock Hill Road next week. The brush work will help alleviate sight and distance safety concerns for drivers and is part of Caltrans' effort to reduce fires throughout California.

There will be one-way traffic control in the work area from Monday, July 10 to Friday, July 14 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. each day. Flaggers will be present to assist drivers during one-way traffic control.

The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected for the rest of the year. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

Chipper Days will continue every second Saturday of the month through September.
