We will convene at 1:00 p.m. near the parking area at Blackie's Pasture and take a walk to South of the Knoll and back, discussing the Richardson's Bay Sanitary District site, South of the Knoll Park, McKegney Green, Blackie's Pasture, and Greenwood Beach along the way. We'll be asking participants to take in the sites as they are now and how the experience could be better in the future. What recreational uses would be a good fit there? How could this area better serve the community?

## Traffic Impact Notice: Slurry Seal Work Beginning Soon

As part of the Town's 2023 Street Maintenance Projects, Doolittle Construction will soon begin work on slurry sealing various streets around Tiburon.

# Greenwood Beach Restoration Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration Begins Circulation

This Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared by the Town of Tiburon pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) statutes and guidelines. It provides support to the conclusion that the Greenwood Beach Restoration Project, with mitigation identified, would not cause a potentially significant impact to the environment. This draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration will circulate for a 33-day public review period from September 20, 2023 - October 23, 2023.



The Greenwood Beach Restoration Project is a nature-based beach restoration and shoreline erosion protection project proposed on approx. 1.4 acres of the Richardson Bay shoreline at Blackie's Pasture.

## Railroad Marsh Maintenance Has Begun

Railroad Marsh maintenance has begun! The Railroad Marsh is behind the Library and Town Hall and serves as a storm water detention facility and passive recreation area.

This maintenance project aims to remove an estimated 750 tons of Cattails and regrade the silt basins. This will provide additional storm flood storage during high tide periods and reduce pollutant and silt loading to the Bay.

It will also help to maximize the native plant and animal species diversity in the area, and allow for better observation and use of the marsh as an educational resource.
