Traffic Impact Notice: Slurry Seal Work Beginning Soon

Doolittle Construction will begin applying slurry seal coatings to streets starting the week of October 9, 2023 (weather dependent).

Slurry seal is a pavement preservation treatment designed to protect and preserve the existing asphalt surface and prolong its integrity. The treatment can take three or four hours to properly cure and receive traffic, so the work will require road closures and traffic restrictions.

Main Street will also be slurry sealed this year and traffic downtown will be impacted. Lower Main Street (Tiburon Boulevard to approx. 46 Main Street) will be closed for most of the day on Monday, October 9 and Upper Main Street will be closed overnight beginning at 11:30 p.m. on Wednesday 10/18 to 5:00 a.m. Thursday morning 10/19. The streets will be accessible to pedestrians during these times.

The Great Shakeout Drill - October 19

On **Thursday, October 19, at 10:19 a.m.**, everyone on the Tiburon Peninsula is encouraged to participate in the annual Great ShakeOut earthquake drill.

Use this time to practice your response during an earthquake and to think about your own personal preparedness. What will the hours, days, and weeks after a major earthquake look like? Are you and your family prepared with essential supplies and communication plans? Do you know where your utilities are located and when and how to shut them off?

To signify the beginning of the drill, the six emergency sirens on the peninsula will sound. At 10:19 a.m., wherever you are, drop, cover and hold. The six sirens on the peninsula are located at:

- Bel Aire School (277 Karen Way)
- Fire Station 10 (4301 Paradise Drive)
- Del Mar Middle School (105 Avenida Miraflores)
- the Tiburon Corporation Yard (199 Kleinert Way)
- Fire Station 11 (1679 Tiburon Boulevard)
- 3700 Paradise Drive

Richardson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary Closed to Watercraft until March 31, 2024

Fall has arrived, and with it, the annual closure of the Richardson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary. Each fall/winter, the sanctuary area closes to all boat traffic - including paddle boards, kayaks, and canoes - to protect tens of thousands of migratory ducks, geese, and shorebirds that use the Bay for re-fueling on their journeys south, or while they winter right here in the Bay Area.

Approximately 900 acres of Bay water are closed, extending south from the edge of the Cove Apartments to the tip of Strawberry Point, east to Belvedere, and north to Blackie's Pasture. The Sanctuary boundaries are designated by buoys and marked pilings.
