Parks & Recreation Master Plan: Next Meeting November 7

The Town is creating a Parks & Recreation Master Plan for Tiburon's public parks and open spaces. The planning process will allow us to take stock of what we have and chart the course for an enhanced, financially sustainable parks and open space system for the years to come.



We want to hear about what you value most about Tiburon's parks and recreation opportunities and what kind of improvements you'd like to see made to them.

Most recently, the Town's consultant team (WRT) hosted a community walking tour down trails along Richardson Bay and recorded feedback from the tour participants about what they would like to see in Tiburon's park spaces.

Next month, WRT will present an update on what they have learned through the discovery phase of the Parks & Recreation Master Plan process. They'll look at the park system geographically and report on their assessments of each individual park site. They will touch on recreational programming and how it relates to our community. The results of the comprehensive survey will be presented, including themes from what they have heard from the community at pop-up events, workshops, and the walking tour.

WRT will make presentations at:

- **Bel-Tib Joint Recreation Committee Board:** November 13, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.
- **Tiburon Town Council:** November 15, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.

Caltrans 2025 Work on Tiburon Boulevard: Submit Public Comment or Attend Public Meeting

Caltrans has proposed a 2025 project on Tiburon Boulevard to:

- add new pavement
- construct Class I, II, and IV bikeways
- modify intersections
- upgrade curb ramps to ADA standards
- upgrade guardrails to current standards
- upgrade signage
- improve pavement delineation
- rehabilitate drainage systems
- and modify electrical systems

Construction for the project is not expected to begin until June 2025.

Caltrans is accepting public comment on the project until November 3, 2023 and is hosting a virtual public meeting on the project on Thursday, October 26, 2023 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The meeting will be held on Zoom ([join meeting](#)).

Are You Ready for Winter?

It's Time to Winterize

All construction sites are required to be winterized between October 15 and May 1 of every year, including erosion and sediment control measures that are specified on project drawings. If your plans do not contain erosion and sediment control measures,

Winter Gas Safety Tips from PG&E

Never use products that can generate dangerous levels of carbon monoxide inside an enclosed area (such as in the home or in an enclosed garage). Generators, outdoor grills, and propane heaters are all examples of household items that can generate carbon monoxide.

- Install carbon monoxide detectors to warn when concentration levels are high. Detectors should be installed on every floor, and near sleeping areas and common areas. Devices should be tested twice a year.
- Never use ovens or stoves for home heating purposes.
- When using the fireplace to stay warm, make sure the flue is open for proper ventilation through the chimney.
- Make sure water heaters and other natural gas appliances have proper ventilation.



Did You ShakeOut?

Last week, the Tiburon Peninsula participated in the Great ShakeOut - the world's largest earthquake drill. At 10:19 a.m., Peninsula sirens sounded and all were encouraged to practice how you would respond during a real earthquake.
