## Storm Drain Repair on Tiburon Boulevard Continues This Week

Caltrans is scheduled to continue repairs on Tiburon Boulevard at Stewart Drive this week. The work will resume Monday 3/11 and last through Friday 3/15, weather permitting.

The work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each day.

Caltrans intends to primarily use a lane shift where both directions of Tiburon Boulevard remain open. However, intermittent one way traffic control with flaggers may be needed between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. for workers to safely finish the work.

Drivers should expect some delays in the area. Please drive cautiously and obey flaggers and message signs in the area. Thank you for your patience.

## Public Notice: Maritime Emergency Preparedness and Security Exercise Downtown Tomorrow 3/12

On Tuesday March 12, Angel Island Tiburon Ferry in partnership with The First Response Group will be conducting a daylong maritime security exercise at the Angel Island Ferry Dock and on vessels near the Tiburon waterfront.

The exercises will focus on a variety of potential threats that utilize a rapid response model, including active shooters, coordinated terrorist attacks, wound care and casualty collection points (i.e. triage and ambulance exchange points). These types of threats associated with ferries and large passenger vessels pose special challenges to vessel crew, passengers, emergency responders and the U.S. Coast Guard. The goal of these exercises is to practice implementation of the U.S. Coast Guard Sector SF Maritime



Active Threat Plan, including tactics recently developed in the Maritime Active Threat/Criminal Mass Casualty Incident Guidance.

Impacts of the training exercises on the public will be minimal. However, during the exercise, residents, businesses and visitors will likely observe increased numbers of uniformed personnel from various local, state, and federal organizations in the downtown area, and the on water training exercises may be visible from downtown and Shoreline Park.





## Alert Marin - Countywide Test on March 23

AlertMarin is the county's primary system to alert residents of an urgent need to evacuate, shelter in place, or take some other protective action.

On **Saturday, March 23**, the County's Office of Emergency Management will conduct a countywide test with a 10:00 am notification sent to opted-in cell phones, landlines, and emails of those registered for AlertMarin.

All who live or work in Marin County are encouraged to sign-up to receive emergency alerts ahead of the test. Those already registered are asked to sign-in and manage their account by verifying their contact information is up to date. Once a person registers with AlertMarin, information can be updated at any time about the registrant's contacts, a child's school, a workplace, or a relative's home.

It only takes about 10 minutes to register for a service that could save your and your families life in the event of a major disaster.
