
Night Work on Tiburon Boulevard


The contractor, JV Lucas Inc., will begin paving on 7/29, but contractors will likely be on site for pre-construction activity beginning 7/24.

The contractor will provide more information to the impacted residents 10 days prior to the start of work on the street segments, including work hours, parking information, and any street closures. If you live on or near one of these street segments, keep an eye out for communications from the contractor.

As always, please drive safely through the work areas as construction and maintenance activities close to the road can be distracting.

Town Council Filing Period Opens Monday, July 15

This November, Tiburon voters will elect two councilmembers to the Tiburon Town Council. The individuals elected will serve 4-year terms, until November 2028.



To become a candidate for Town Council, you must be over 18 years of age and a registered voter in the Town of Tiburon. Potential candidates may obtain the required paperwork to get on the ballot beginning Monday, July 15 (today!) and must file completed paperwork with the Town Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 9.

Residents of the Tiburon Peninsula may drive their vegetation cuttings and "slash" to the dirt parking lot at Blackie's Pasture to be piled for chipper removal by the Tiburon Peninsula Fire Protection District & Tiburon Public Works.



In an effort to meet the Marin County Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan's goal to remove overgrowth and create Defensible Space for residents of the Peninsula, these events serve to continue to make our area better protected against wildfire. The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected for the rest of the year. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

Chipper Days are always the second Saturday of the month from May through September. The remaining 2024 schedule is as follows:

Saturday, August 10, 2024 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Saturday, September 14, 2024 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Do You Have a Tiburon Business License?

The Town has always valued its relationship with our

business community, and we are pleased to announce some changes to our business licensing procedures that are designed to streamline the process for remitting taxes to the Town.

The Town has contracted with the HdL Companies to provide the business community with additional support for all aspects of business licensing, including online application and payments.



HdL and the Town are working closely together to ensure a seamless transition, and we anticipate the new online system will be up and running in the coming weeks. Current business license holders will receive communications directly with instructions on how to utilize the online portal, how to seek customer support, or, if you prefer, how to continue to submit your annual renewals by mail.

Fire Season is Coming - Get Permits for Generators Now



The best thing you can do to be prepared for wildfire season and the potential loss of power for several days is to get ready now.

If you intend to incorporate a large capacity power source into your preparedness toolkit, such as to provide backup power for a medical device or refrigerator, there are large capacity electric or battery operated 'generators' available.

Tiburon Jewish Festival - Sunday, July 21 in Zelinsky Park

On Sunday, July 21, the Town of Tiburon will celebrate Jewish culture and diversity with a free outdoor event featuring upscale international cuisine, complimentary wine tasting, live music and interactive activities for all ages.

The second annual **Tiburon Jewish Festival** will take place 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. at Zelinsky Park, 1505 Tiburon Blvd. The event is open to residents and visitors alike free of charge; registration is required.

Live music will be performed by San Francisco-based Israeli reggae and world music artist Lior



Ben-Hur and his band, Sol Tevé; classic rock keyboardist Jef Labes, known for his work with Van Morrison and Bonnie Raitt; and The Ferris Wheels, a cover band led by a Hasidic rabbi.

A variety of booths will offer kosher cuisine reflecting Jewish life around the world - from Middle Eastern favorites such as hummus and shwarma to traditional New York Jewish deli sandwiches and American BBQ. Covenant, a winery featuring vintages from across California and Israel, will host no-cost wine tastings.

The festival will also feature activities such as a cooking demonstration by chef Micah Siva; a paint-and-sip session with professional artist Desiree Edelman; a workshop on the ancient art of Jewish scribing taught by expert scribe Levi Potash; and a kids 'fun zone.' Seating will be available throughout the park.
