# Daily One-Way Traffic Control on Tiburon Boulevard Monday 6/24 – Friday 6/28

Caltrans has scheduled annual vegetation management work on Tiburon Boulevard at the end of June. The brush work will help alleviate sight and distance safety concerns for drivers and is part of Caltrans' effort to reduce fires throughout California.

There will be one-way traffic control on Tiburon Boulevard between Trestle Glen Boulevard and Rock Hill Road from Monday 6/24 to Friday 6/28 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day.

Flaggers will be present to assist drivers during one-way traffic control periods. A detour through the neighborhoods will be marked when necessary.

The work has been planned to begin after local schools begin summer break, and between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to minimize traffic impacts.

The contractor, JV Lucas Inc., will provide more information to the impacted residents 10 days prior to the start of work on the street segments, including work hours, parking information, and any street closures. If you live on or near one of these street segments, keep an eye out for communications from the contractor.

## Yellow Bus Passes on Sale!

Yellow School Bus passes are on sale now for the next school year. This program helps reduce traffic congestion along Tiburon Boulevard during school bell times. Passes for the upcoming school year went on sale on May 20 and are selling fast.

Passes will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. We hope to accommodate as many riders as possible, but families who cannot secure a pass will be placed on a waitlist. The cost of an annual pass is \$345 for one-way rides (this equates to less than \$2 per ride!).
