Chipper Days are Back this Summer! The next Chipper Day of the season is **Saturday, June 8 at Blackie's Pasture from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

Residents of the Tiburon Peninsula may drive their vegetation cuttings and "slash" to the dirt parking lot at Blackie's Pasture to be piled for chipper removal by the Tiburon Peninsula Fire Protection District & Tiburon Public Works.



In an effort to meet the Marin County Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan's goal to remove overgrowth and create Defensible Space for residents of the Peninsula, these events serve to continue to make our area better protected against wildfire. The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected for the rest of the year. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

A Word from the Police Department: Protect Yourself From Burglary

While Tiburon is a safe town, property crimes, such as home and auto burglaries, do occur. Home burglaries almost always occur when residents are not home and their house appears unoccupied. Here are some tips for some things you can do to protect your home from thieves:

- If you have an alarm system, make sure it is working properly and activate it anytime you leave the house.
- Work with neighbors and ask them to keep an eye out and immediately report anyone or anything suspicious on your property. Do the same for them. When going out of town, consider getting a house sitter that can come by regularly.
- Stop newspapers and mail when going out of town. Ask neighbors to check for and pick up any packages left on your doorstep.
- Leave lights and even radios and televisions on timers in various places around your home anytime you go out. Occupied homes are seldom targeted so give your home the lived in and occupied look.
- Motion lights and security cameras are good to have all the time, not just when travelling.
- When going out of town, register your home on the Vacation House Check list. Officers will check the perimeter of your home occasionally, as time permits. Call (415) 789-2801 to register your home.
