Summer 2024 Street Maintenance Project Wraps Up with Slurry Seal on Various Streets

The Summer 2024 Pavement Maintenance Project will wrap up with an application of slurry seal coating on the week of 8/26.

Slurry seal coatings protect and preserve the existing asphalt surface and prolong its integrity. The treatment, once applied to your roadway, can take three or four hours to properly cure and receive traffic of any kind. The product requires the impacted street be closed and restricted to traffic during application and for several hours after. Avoid the construction area, as the oil used in the treatment will stain carpets, floors, and other items.

Heads Up Mar East Residents!

The Town would first like to extend an additional thank you to Mar East residents for their patience in repaving the road this year. We recognize that this is a challenging street to work on and sincerely appreciate your patience and flexibility during construction.

Mar East will be slurry sealed on Monday 8/26 and Tuesday 8/27. Each work day, one portion of the roadway will be **closed** to vehicle traffic and street parking, and the other portion of the roadway will become **two-way**. MMWD Pipeline Replacement Project



The 2024 Pipeline Replacement Project will replace nearly 3,500 feet of aging cast iron pipeline beneath Paradise Drive in Tiburon.

The 6-inch pipeline along in this section was first installed in 1922, and the welded steel pipeline replacing it will increase reliability and seismic resiliency of the Water District's water infrastructure. A contractor working for the District began work earlier this week and construction is expected to last several months.

There will be alternating one-way traffic control along Paradise Drive during construction. Please obey all flaggers and drive safely.

Fire Season is Coming - Get Permits for Generators Now



The best thing you can do to be prepared for wildfire season and the potential loss of power for several days is to get ready now.

If you intend to incorporate a large capacity power source into your preparedness toolkit, such as to provide backup power for a medical device or refrigerator, there are large capacity electric or battery operated 'generators' available.

Safeguard your home from fire and check your gutters! Clear rain gutters during fire season as well as the rainy season and install a noncombustible gutter cover. Ensure your roof has a metal drip edge installed that completely covers the space above your gutter system. Many houses are lost to fire when embers ignite litter in the rain gutters even if the roof is fire retardant.
