The Climate Action Plan outlines strategies to reach the Town's goal to reduce greenhouse gas emissions 50% below 1990 levels. The CAP was adopted in 2022 and helps us understand how the local community contributes to climate change and what actions make the biggest impact.

The report will provide an update on progress toward these goals and highlight ongoing sustainability programs, including efforts on transportation, building electrification, waste reduction, and more. Keep Tiburon Beautiful: Waste Receptacle Guidelines



Please remember that all garbage and recycling receptacles must be stored out of view from public streets except on collection days ([TMC 26-5.1](#)). Containers may be placed out for collection on your designated pickup day but must be returned to a concealed location within 24 hours of collection.

This requirement helps maintain our town's aesthetic appeal. All waste must be properly contained to prevent spillage, odors, or access by wildlife ([TMC 26-5](#)). Thank you for helping keep Tiburon beautiful by properly storing your waste receptacles.

As a reminder: if you choose to build an enclosure for your receptacles, you may need Design Review and will require a building permit. Contact Planning at (415) 435-7390 with questions.



Fire Hazard Severity Zones: Submit Comments

The California State Fire Marshal released update Fire Hazard Severity Zone maps for the North Coast and Bay Area earlier this year.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 51178, the State Fire Marshal shall identify areas in the state as moderate, high, and very high fire hazard severity zones based on consistent statewide criteria and based on severity of fire hazard that is expected to prevail in those areas.
