As many of you know, I have been working very hard these past few years to bring Broadband to Tiburon. I am working with Caltrans to incorporate Broadband into the SR-131 Project, which could save the town \$2 million dollars or more. Broadband will not only lower our prices and improve service, but will help Caltrans provide adaptive traffic signals that will help reduce traffic along Tiburon Boulevard.

## Traffic Advisory: Caltrans Vegetation Management Work scheduled to begin week of July 7, 2025 on SR-131

Caltrans has scheduled annual vegetation management work on Tiburon Boulevard starting the week of July 7.

There will be one-way traffic control in effect on portions of Tiburon Boulevard from Monday 7/7 to Friday 7/11 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day.

Flaggers will be present to assist drivers during the work. A detour through neighborhoods will be marked and implemented when possible.

Please drive with caution and expect some delays. Thank you for your patience.

## Summer Paving Project: Paradise Drive

Paradise Drive from Mar West to Agreste Way to be paved in July



Tentatively starting the week of July 7, the Town of Tiburon will begin the Paradise Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project, which will improve the roadway between the intersections of Paradise Drive/Mar West and Paradise Drive/Agreste Way. The work involves reconstructing the existing pavement and is expected to take about 45 working days.

Lane closures and temporary delays are anticipated, but traffic control personnel will be onsite daily to help guide vehicles through the area. Residents will receive door hanger notices with specific dates and details before construction begins.

Town staff will also be onsite throughout the project to oversee progress and address any concerns. We appreciate your patience as we complete this much-needed roadwork.

## Caltrans Activation of Metering Lights for 101 Northbound Onramps

Caltrans will be activating ramp metering lights starting on **Tuesday, June 24** to reduce congestion, improve traffic flow, and enhance safety on Highway 101.

## Storm Drain Improvements Coming to Karen Way, Claire Way, and Bel Aire Play Area



Tentatively starting the week of June 23, the Town of Tiburon will begin a storm drain rehabilitation project to improve drainage on portions of Karen Way, Claire Way, and within the Bel Aire Play Area. The project also includes upgrades to street drainage in front of Bel Aire School. Work will involve trench excavation to replace aging storm drain pipes, followed by full street repaving in the affected areas. Construction is expected to last about 35 days.

Lane closures and minor delays are anticipated, but flaggers will be onsite daily to help guide traffic. Town staff will be present throughout the project to oversee the work and respond to any concerns. Residents will receive door hanger notices with more detailed information as the project approaches.

Thank you in advance for your patience as we complete these important improvements.

## Traffic Advisory: Caltrans Utility Potholing on SR-131 Work is ongoing Monday-Friday & Sunday evenings.

Caltrans has begun utility potholing on both directions of the full length of Tiburon Blvd. also known as State Route 131 (SR-131) in Marin County from the U.S. 101 exit to Main Street (approximately four miles).

Work is performed at night, between 8:00 PM and 6:00 AM, Monday through Friday, and now includes Sundays.

Workers will perform potholing on SR-131 to safely locate underground utilities in preparation for the upcoming paving project of SR-131 scheduled in 2026.

Eastbound and westbound lanes of SR-131 will be subject to one-way traffic control. Only one lane will be open at a time, with traffic alternating directions through the work zone.

All work depends on weather. **Normal project work hours are 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday**
