I hope that you all had a chance to come to Tiburon's Juneteenth celebration this past weekend! It was a wonderful time, and everyone enjoyed the celebration.



Traffic Advisory: Summer Infrastructure Projects Planned Work scheduled to begin in July

Summer Paving: Paradise Drive

The Town's Paradise Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project will commence mid July and is expected to take about 45 days. The work involves reconstructing the pavement on Paradise Drive between Mar West and Agreste Way. [Read more.](#)

Bring your vegetation clippings for free disposal



On Saturday, July 12, residents of the Tiburon Peninsula may drive their vegetation cuttings – as well as tree stumps of any size - to the dirt parking lot at Blackie's Pasture for disposal by the Tiburon Fire Protection District & Tiburon Public Works.

These events serve to make our area better protected against wildfire and help us to meet the Marin County Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan goal to remove overgrowth and create defensible space for residents of the Tiburon Peninsula. The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

Chipper Days are always the second Saturday of the month from May through September and are hosted by Tiburon Fire Protection District, Tiburon Department of Public Works, and Mill Valley Refuse Service.

Class 2 e-Bike Ordinance Goes into Effect July 1



Going into effect on July 1, 2025, all Class 2 and Class 3 e-bike riders in Tiburon must be 16 and older. All e-bike and traditional bike riders must wear a helmet. Class-2 e-bikes are operated with a throttle and do not have pedal assist. Class 1 e-bikes, which are pedal-assisted and do not have a throttle, remain operable for youth under 16. The County of Marin has created a [website](#) with information to help parents and riders to stay safe and legal on the road.

Gate Safeguards Requirement Now in Effect

Large and automatic gates must be certified by July 1, 2025

Per [Tiburon Ordinance No. 601 N.S.](#), property owners with automatic vehicular gates and any gate more than 48 inches in width or more than 84 inches in height are required to obtain a written certification for each gate, by July 1, 2025 and at least once every five years



If you have a gate that requires inspection and written certification, please provide the written certification to the Building Division by October 1, 2025. Please contact the Building Division with any questions at (415) 435-7380 or building@townoftiburon.org.

Prescribed Burns Scheduled for Mt. Tam Watershed

Burn plans scheduled week of July 1; smoke will be present

Marin County Fire and Marin Water have announced tentative prescribed burn plans for as early as Tuesday, July 1, on the Mt. Tam Watershed, near the northern side of Bon Tempe Lake.



The burn area may cover up to 40 acres near Sky Oaks Road and Sunnyside Trail. [View map](#)

Smoke will be visible to surrounding communities and possibly Highway 101. Do not call 9-1-1 if you see smoke in this area and heed trail signs for safety.

Sky Oaks Road will remain open but could see brief delays due to smoke or engine movement.

Sunnyside Trail will be closed during operations.

Emergency Siren Test Scheduled for Saturday, July 5



Monthly siren tests on the Tiburon Peninsula resume this Saturday, July 5 at noon and will now sound for 15 seconds on the first Saturday of each month, in sync with other Southern Marin cities. The sirens are shorter than before but still loud enough to test the system and remind the community to stay prepared. If you hear the siren at any time other than a scheduled test, it may indicate an emergency — check emergency.marincounty.gov, the [Town website](#), or tune in to 840 AM radio for updates.

The sirens don't reach every part of Tiburon or Belvedere, so it's important to sign up for Alert Marin to receive emergency notifications by phone, text, or email. You can register, verify your info, or learn more by visiting www.AlertMarin.org

On Friday, June 13, the Tiburon Police Department conducted a DUI and driver's license checkpoint to help keep our roads safe.


Vehicles Screened: 398

We were proud to partner with officers from Belvedere PD and Ross PD for this operation. Checkpoint locations are chosen based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes.

The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints is to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off roads.

Funding for this checkpoint was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
