

Residents of the Tiburon Peninsula may drive their vegetation cuttings – as well as tree stumps of any size - to the dirt parking lot at Blackie's Pasture for disposal by the Tiburon Fire Protection District & Tiburon Public Works this Saturday, August 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

These events serve to make our area better protected against wildfire and help us to meet the Marin County Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan goal to remove overgrowth and create defensible space for residents of the Tiburon Peninsula. The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

News from Tiburon Police Department

Tiburon Police to Hold DUI Checkpoint Friday, August 8 at Undisclosed Location from 8:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m.



On August 8th, 2025, the Tiburon Police Department will conduct a driving under the influence (DUI) Checkpoint from 8 p.m. to 3 a.m. at an undisclosed location.

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on data showing incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off the road.

“Impaired drivers put others on the road at significant risk,” Captain Jarrod Yee said. “Any prevention measures that reduce the number of impaired drivers on our roads significantly improve traffic safety.”

The Tiburon Police Department reminds the public that impaired driving is not just from alcohol. Some prescription medications and over-the-counter drugs may interfere with driving. While medicinal and recreational marijuana are legal, driving under the influence of marijuana is illegal.

Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.

Funding for this program was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

E-bikes: Are you familiar with the latest ordinances?

Electric bikes, motorcycles, and scooters are increasingly common on Tiburon's roads and paths and the ordinances applicable to their use have changed recently. Because these bikes, scooters and motorcycles are self-propelled, not only are they subject to Tiburon's Municipal Code, but they are also subject to the California Vehicle Code (CVC).



Make sure you and the riders in your family are up to speed on the updated ordinances and are riding safely while having fun doing so.
