Traffic Advisory: Run Tiburon 5k/10k Race Sunday, September 7 from 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.



The Run Tiburon 5k/10k race is back this Sunday, September 7! **There will be traffic control, road closures, and detours in place downtown on Sunday morning to accommodate the the race course.** The race starts at 7:30 a.m. Closures and traffic control will begin in the area at 5:00 a.m.

♀ Beach Road between Tiburon Boulevard and Main Street (by the Post Office) will be closed between 5:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on race day.

♂ The inbound lane of Tiburon Boulevard will be closed from Mar West Street (near the library), through the downtown area, and on Paradise Drive up

to the Mar West Street intersection (near the sanitary district building) between 7:15am and 8:15am. A detour will route inbound drivers around the race course through Mar West Street.

♀ Cars will be held periodically at the Tiburon Boulevard and San Rafael Avenue intersection as racers pass.

♂ Professional traffic control will be in effect. [View course maps.](#)

Please pay attention to detour route signs and flaggers to assist you in safely reaching your destination. The remainder of the course will be on the Old Rail Trail. Drivers utilizing San Rafael Avenue to access Belvedere may experience some delays, but there will be no additional road closures in the area.

Traffic Advisory: Paradise Drive Paving Project



The Paradise Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project is now underway. This project will improve the roadway between the intersections of Paradise Drive/Mar West and Paradise Drive/Agreste Way.

The work may cause some temporary delays. Traffic control personnel is onsite daily to help guide vehicles through the work area, and any detours are marked. Drivers are encouraged to give themselves plenty of time to navigate the area safely.

Chipper Day - Last Call to Dispose of Vegetation Clippings Blackie's Pasture | Saturday, September 13, 9:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m.

Residents of the Tiburon Peninsula may drive their vegetation cuttings – as well as tree stumps of any size - to the dirt parking lot at Blackie's Pasture for disposal by the Tiburon Fire Protection District & Tiburon Public Works this Saturday, September 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This marks the last Chipper Day of the season.

These events serve to make our area better protected against wildfire and help us to meet the Marin County Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan goal to remove overgrowth and create defensible space for residents of the Tiburon Peninsula. The season for vegetation management is already here and dry conditions are expected. Get ahead of it this year and be proactive for you, your neighbors, and your community!

The next scheduled meeting is Wednesday, September 24 at 7:00 p.m.




