## Open Space Vegetation Cleanup Scheduled for October

The Town's Public Works Department has hired a contractor to perform vegetation maintenance in two of Tiburon's open space parcels: one off of Cibrian Drive and one off of Via Los Altos. The work will focus on reducing fire risk and removing unwanted and invasive plant species. Maintenance is scheduled to begin the first week of October and may continue through November. ## Richardson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary Seasonal Closure Off Limits to Boat Traffic October 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026



The Richardson Bay Audubon Center & Sanctuary reminds the community that Sanctuary waters are closed to all boat traffic—including paddle boards, kayaks, and canoes—from October 1 through March 31 to protect tens of thousands of migratory birds. The 900-acre closure area, managed as a wildlife sanctuary by Audubon, is marked by buoys and pilings.

This unique closure protects tens of thousands of migratory ducks, geese, and shorebirds that use the Bay for re-fueling on their journeys south, or while they over-winter right here in Bay Area. Due to its critical importance to these birds, Richardson Bay

has also been designated as an Important Bird Area by Bird Life International and National Audubon.


This year's Chipper Day program - running from May through September - was a remarkable success, with record participation and the largest haul of vegetation to date!
