

## Emergency Supply Checklist

I/We have stored the following emergency supplies:

- Food for family members and pets for 5-7 days. *Remember grocery stores may be closed if the disaster has caused property damage. Trucks may be unable to make deliveries to restock shelves. Existing stock will disappear quickly.*
- At least 1 gallon of water per person per day. The more water you can store, the better. Calculate your emergency water reserve needs: \_\_\_ people in household x \_\_\_ days reserve (minimum 5 recommended) = \_\_\_ gallons needed.
- Cash and coins.
- First aid items.
- Flashlight, radio, tools, sanitation supplies.
- Camping gear. *Tent, lanterns, sleeping bags, and a stove can double as emergency equipment.*
- Car and workplace mini-survival kits.
- Prescription medications.
- Fire extinguisher.
- Cooking equipment and eating utensils.
- Health and safety supplies.

## Evacuation Priority List

*What should be in my to-go bag?*

Before the need to evacuate rises, think about what you will need to take with you and make a priority list of items that you would take if you only had 10 minutes to evacuate your home.

Your list should include only items that can be hand-carried. Consider adding the location of each item in your house to the list. You may want to create separate lists for each family member or pet.

For example:

- Family Heirlooms
- Important Documents/Computer Files
- Clothing
- Medications
- Pets
- Disaster Supply Kit

## Personal/Family Disaster Plan Checklist

Using the above information, please use the following items as a disaster plan checklist for you and/or your family:

- I/We have stored emergency food and water and other supplies.
- I/We know two ways to evacuate our neighborhood by vehicle or on foot.
- I/We know the location of our utility valves and know how to shut them off. We have attached the necessary tools to shut-offs valves.
- I/We have designated an out-of-area relative or friend as our emergency contact and have instructed family and friends to contact that person to inquire about our safety.
- I/We have created an Evacuation Priority List in case the need to evacuate arises.
- I/We have registered for Alert Marin and Nixle emergency alerts.
