This phase of the project consists of installing conductors in the newly installed underground conduits that run to each property. Contractors working for PG&E will be performing this work for the next few months with Town staff providing oversight and support throughout this phase.


Once this phase is complete, transfer of utility service from overhead to underground facilities will occur. This will require coordination between property owners, their individual service lateral installation contractors, utility operators, and the Town of Tiburon.
