- Not enough playgrounds ●●





BATHROOMS @ PLAYGROUNDS!

RECREATION

 Focus on improving **recreational opportunities for teens and seniors**, while maintaining high-quality experience for all members of the community. ●●●

 Increase community awareness of and **programming** at The Ranch, and bring the Community Room at City Hall back into use. ●●●

 **Add and enhance playgrounds** distributed throughout Tiburon, to create walkable playgrounds for many residents. ●●●

 Strategically develop **recreation amenities** that meet community needs. These include pickleball, tennis, and areas for multiuse play. ●●●

 Explore the feasibility of developing a **small outdoor public pool**, and explore options to improve Tiburon residents' ease of use of **swimming pools** at Strawberry, Mill Valley, Tiburon Peninsula Club. ●●●●●

 Provide **kayak/SUP launch**; work with the Town of Belvedere to create good water access from Beach Road, and work with the County to improve water access at Paradise Beach Park. ●●●

Ensure that when adding to recreation amenities you do so in a way that does not disturb the enjoyment of park users and those who live nearby.

Have considered room building for these uses. Allow use year-round, will have courts. Nois doesn't disturb neighbors as much.

Also consider in the long term whether a recreation building could be placed downtown - also would help business downtown.

All these plans do not account for the many people who like the parks the way they are - bucolic + quiet. You seem to want to disrupt the bucolic feel of the parks while keeping part of the space bucolic!

ACCESS + VISIBILITY



Improve awareness of parks, which amenities and facilities are available at them, and how to access them. ● ● ● ●



Make improvements to the **Old Rail Trail** to optimize safety for all users. Where adequate space exists, **provide separate trails for bikes & pedestrians**. Elsewhere, design for slow speeds and establish clear understanding of shared space. ● ● ●



Improve **safe access** across Tiburon Boulevard to Richardson Bay Park, especially from Avenida Miraflores intersection with Tiburon Boulevard (at Del Mar School). ● ● ●

Crossing at Tiburon Blvd and Stewart is still a disaster. Consider alternatives Pedestrian Tunnel?

How can we encourage more safe travel during walking along Tiburon Blvd? Traffic is a problem

SAFE bike lanes + crossings + bike racks. Reduce traffic?

ENVIRONMENT



Create **rain gardens** paired with paths downtown, where flooding has been a persistent problem. Connect to Belvedere resilience improvements along the shoreline. ●



Incorporate **sea level rise adaptation** into park design at Richardson Bay, including consideration of the drainage through Blackie's Pasture and nature-based improvements at Greenwood Beach. ●



Incorporate **stormwater infiltration** into design of Richardson Bay Park. ●



Create a **community garden** and work out logistics of maintenance. ●



ELEMENTS

The three alternative conceptual plans for Richardson Bay Lineal Park test different amenity additions, improvements, and arrangements. Each plan integrates a mix of elements (shown to the right) that are arranged in varying ways to form distinct nodes along the lineal park.

The elements are categorized by the character of activity: restoration and adaptation, nature-based recreation, passive recreation, and active recreation.





