Salt Works Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Improvements

About the Project

The Sewerage Agency of Southern Marin will be modernizing the existing Salt Works Sanitary Sewer Pump Station, which serves many residents north of Tiburon Boulevard between Highway 101 corridor and Trestle Glen Boulevard. The pump station is located at 241 Tiburon Blvd.

The existing pump station is over 35 years old and project work will improve its reliability, operational safety, and meet current municipal pump station standards. A \$4.2 million contract was awarded to JMB Construction, Inc., in July 2025. Construction is expected to be completed by November 2026.

Please expect noise from construction equipment and concrete cutting saws from October 20 – 30, 2025, Monday thru Friday during 8AM-5PM. Expect a 14 hour work day (8AM-10PM) on October 22, 2025. Water and sewer service will **not** be impacted during this project.
