Project Narrative

Tiburon Belveron Mini Park is an opportunity to provide enhanced amenities to the linear park site that connects Tiburon Boulevard to hillside trails. The design is intended to maintain and enhance the existing landscaping and mature trees, provide additional recreational experiences for the community and enhance the entry to give the park a more welcoming and accessible experience. The design includes a lawn area with a small nature playground and bicycle parking, picnic areas, interpretive signage and enhanced habitat for birds and pollinators. An accessible walkway leads to the central park area, while trails connect to the upper reaches and hillside open space.
