

Project Description

Cypress Hollow Park is a 0.53-acre mini park at the corner of Rancho Drive and Cypress Hollow Drive within a residential neighborhood. The Town of Tiburon is developing a conceptual design to guide future renovations of the park. Informed by community surveys from the 2025 "Tiburon Parks, Recreation & Open Space Master Plan," the design explores reorganized amenities, inclusive play, improved accessibility, and thoughtful, low-maintenance upgrades that preserve the site's trees and character. This early design is intended to reflect the Town and community's wants and needs. No final decisions have been made, and your feedback is important in helping shape the future of the park.
