FINAL COST EVALUATION

Pursuant to Tiburon Town Council Resolution 32-2015, the basis for the Building Permit Fee shall be the total valuation of the project. "Valuation of the project" includes all of the actual costs incurred for the completion of the project. These costs include, but are not limited to, architectural and engineering fees, site preparation, demolition, rough and finish carpentry, electrical, plumbing, mechanical, scaffolding and other equipment rentals, grading, drainage, and winterization activities. Where work is performed or materials supplied without monetary compensation, such as fees included for supplies and appliances purchased by the property owner, **the fair market value of labor and/or materials supplied shall be used for project valuation calculation purposes. Contractor profit/overhead must be included in total cost.**
