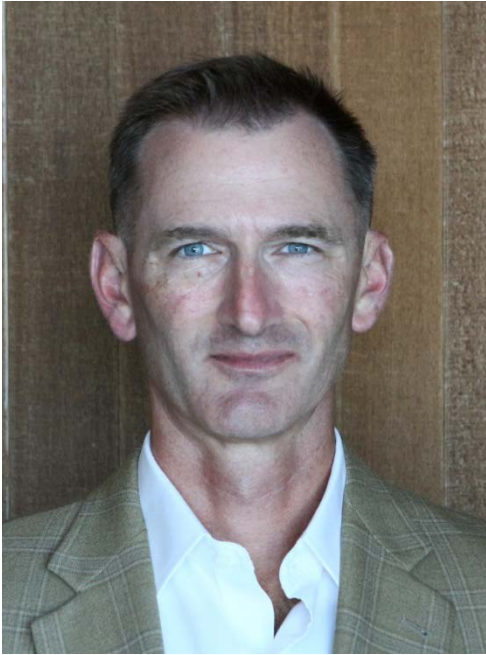




David Kulik

David was appointed to the Council in July 2017, and subsequently elected to a three-year term in the November 2017 Special Election. He serves as the Town representative to the Marin Telecommunications Agency, and also serves as the Town alternate to MCE (formerly Marin Clean Energy). David currently sits on the Town's Finance and Utility Undergrounding ad hoc sub committees.

Prior to the Town Council, David served for four years on the Tiburon Planning Commission, acting as Vice Chair in 2014, and Chair in 2015.

David has been active in the local community in other capacities for several years. He has served on the Board of the Lyford Cove - Old Tiburon Neighborhood Association (LCOTNA) since 2012. He is also a former Board Member, Treasurer, and President of the Belvedere Tennis Club (which, interestingly, is located entirely in Tiburon!).

David is a commercial pilot for a major airline and a Reserve Officer in the United States Marine Corps, where he currently holds the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. Prior to moving to Tiburon in 2007, he served for nearly 12 years on active duty in the Marines, where his primary occupational specialty was piloting the F/A-18 aircraft as a Naval Aviator.

David holds a bachelor's degree in Physics from Lake Forest College, and an MBA in Finance from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. He lives in Old Tiburon with his wife Katie and two daughters, who are happily studying in the RUSD.
